- Sailing plan (route, alternatives, broad planning, UTC, language)
- Charts & Bookwork's (Imray preferred)
- Tides (Hi/Lo water and current)
- Locks/Bridges, obstructions on the track
- Ports of arrival
- Guest flags
- Paperwork/Formalities entry UK

PREPARATIONS ON BOARD


Safety and communication

- Basics in order (technique and papers)
- VHF radio (groups MMSI)
- Maps online/offline (Imray/Navionics etc)
- Safety (liferaft, lifejacket, lifelines, seasick preparation incl. Cola)
- EPIRB – Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon (and/or)
PLB – Personal Locator Beacon
- Food/drinks
- Clothing
- Pay attention to rules regarding import/export of goods



PREPARATIONS JUST BEFORE *and during the trip*

- Passage plan
- Weather forecast (Windfinder, Windy, Zeeweer, Passageweather.com) and Navtex/VHF!
- Sea state (situation at sea)
- Current affairs at sea/on board
- Everything seaworthy on board
- Easy food/drink ready(cold/warm)



DURING THE TRIP

always have a "plan B"

- Navigating at sea
- Staying alert ("Plan B" ready)
- Following current affairs/at sea/ on board
- Adjusting plans where necessary
- Contact with passengers on board/home and rest of the group of boats

RETURN TRIP

Always stay alert!

- Preparation as outbound trip
- Stay alert to changing circumstances
- Don't get overconfident!!!
- Return formalities in EU/Schengen


